- Approximately 20% of Kaiser Permanente medical residents in California are from a UC school.
- Partnering with UC Davis on "Prep Medico", a multi-faceted initiative that will provide scholarships, mentorship and internship opportunities for pre-med and medical students to expand diversity in medicine and ultimately increase the number of Latinos who choose to become physicians.
- \$1.1 million grant to UCLA Center for Health Policy for the California Health Interview Survey.
- Between 2013 2015 Kaiser Permanente contributed over \$10.9 million to UC scholarships and programs.
- In southern California alone, Kaiser Permanente has 1,661 medical doctors that graduated from a UC medical school.

- Call our advice nurses 24/7. They will assess you situation and help you decide what to do or make an appointment for you to get care.
- Choose how you want to have your appointment. See your doctor in person, or schedule either a telephone or video appointment, when appropriate and where available.
- **Email your doctor anytime**. Send your doctor's office an email with nonurgent questions and get a response usually within 48 hours—often sooner.
- Manage your care online at kp.org. Make and cancel routine appointments, refill
 prescriptions, see most lab test results, and more.
- Use the Kaiser Permanente app. Download our app to your smartphone and use all the online features of kp.org from your phone, plus find locations near you, and more.

 - Mammograms
 - Cholesterol screenings



Copays keep things simple

- No matter what type you receive, you only have a copay.
- And you'll pay just a copay for prescription drugs, too.
- If you get additional services during your visit, you'll get a bill in the mail later for any extra copays or coinsurance you owe.

Baldwin Park, Downey and South Bay


• Manhattan Beach: Coming in January of 2016 is a 9,000 foot facility located at S Sepulveda Blvd.


