



How are you feeling in general? (Campus Nov 2020 vs. Feb 2021)





Does not ask about or prioritizes personal well- being	46 (18%)	 "I think they care more about the work getting done. I don't think they care who does it and less regarding how they are doing." "I was recently transferred to my third supervisor in 18 months. They supervise many people and it feels like I am the least of their worries, and they don't check in on how I am doing, just what I am doing." "Because performance is more important than our personal situations and feelings." "My supervisor does not care at all about the well-being of the staff. With outrageous statements like "you should be happy you have the privilege to work in such a great place and this should be enough to keep you happy so stop complaining" and other demoralizing things."
Increased workloads	29 (11%)	 "I have expressed to my supervisor how my workload is affecting my well-being without much being done to address the root cause that we are understaffed and overworked with no end in sight." "We are always understaffed and expected to do the same amount of work that is expected with a full staff" "I just keep getting asked to do more things, more service, despite everything going on."
Lack of communication	29 (11%)	 "no one on one check-ins, I don't feel my supervisor cares what I'm doing or how I'm doing" "My immediate supervisor refuses to have check-in meetings, doesn't answer my emails, has never once since the pandemic asked me how I was, etc. However, he is a very powerful faculty member and clearly campus is going to let him do whatever he wants, regardless of how it might affect people." "No one has individually reached out even though I am teaching a new course, and this is my first time teaching on Zoom. I've attended group Zoom sessions where people have answered questions helpfully, but I feel a bit left on my own."
COVID exposure concerns	20 (8%)	 "Mainly I'm uncomfortable with the fact we are forced to be going in to the office regularly without the vaccine available to us. We are essential enough to go into the office on a weekly basis, but not to qualify for the vaccine? How about waiting until we are vaccinated before forcing us to go in. testing only goes so far." "Management is more concerned about getting us back on campus as quickly as possible, rather than at a time when safety can be ensured." "I support a laboratory class that is currently remote, yet I feel my supervisor is pushing us to work on campus and has been pushing for in-person activities to resume, and hasn't


		taken into account that the staff would then be exposed to any students that wish to take part."
No recognition/appreciation	17 (6%)	 "Required to complete a lot of work in short work period, it's a struggle. The last communication I had with this person made me feel unappreciated, overwhelmed, and almost accusing me of not providing accurate details. It set the tone for the rest of the day to be somewhat negative." "Because I do excellent work, receive strong positive feedback from Cal community, but not from my boss (who admits that is a growth area for him)." "No acknowledgement, no inclusion in decision making processes beyond a select group. Your own experience and expertise takes a back seat to this group of 'experts'."
Bullying/Harassment	13 (5%)	 "My immediate supervisor has been bullying me and excluding from most departmental business for the last four years." "He is an old white male faculty and is above the law. He treats all women and especially women of color with disdain and aggression." "My supervisor is threatening me and telling me that she is going to fire me."
Supervisor is overwhelmed/too busy	11 (4%)	 "I think since curtailment, staff are under more pressure; I feel my sup. is getting pressure from above to move on projects, and that sense of stress is flowing downwards. Also, the mantra of "let's be kind to everyone, this is a rough time" is just wearing thin. I feel hammered on about tiny details, while the big picture is not being shared with me. I am so very grateful to be employed, but work is the most stressful it's been since last March." "The work has not reduced but our staff time and budgets have. I can only speak for myself, but I suspect my managers feel the same as I am working under those conditions: over-extended and stressed with no certain relief in sight. If my suspicions are correct, then it would make sense that I feel my supervisors aren't prioritizing my well-being because they are likely struggling as well."

Both Academic and Staff respondents had similar reasons why they would be unlikely to exchange their dedicated workspace. Top reasons for both populations were:


- Required for the job.
- Work requires confidential/private space.
- Helps with productivity/collaboration/coordination/quiet space/convenience.
- Do not want to share. / Want personalized space. / It's a benefit from UCB.
- Need secure storage.

Many Staff respondents also expressed concern about the health/safety/security/cleanliness of a shared workspace, especially in the context of the pandemic.

Despite the note, "Any employee who needs workspace related accommodations will be accommodated, including having a dedicated space instead of sharing a space," several respondents expressed distress, suspicion, and alarm about the timing and intentions of the question.


Many academic respondents seemed confused by the question as they felt their spaces were not negotiable, and they already had the freedom of remote work before the pandemic.

If you have dependent care needs (for children or adults), have you used any of the 120 hours of campus-sponsored emergency backup care available through Bright Horizons ?



How satisfied were you with the back-up care program?





How many times did you use the back-up care program?




